WASTE CATEGORY 1

Solid wastes which will not decompose or will decompose only very slowly:

Topsoil, Subsoil, and Stone

Sand

Clay

Silica (Excluding Finely Powdered Waste)

Concrete

Brickwork

Pottery

China

Enamels

Ceramics

Mica and Abrasives

Excavated Road Metal (well weathered)

Hard-core

Mineral Processing Wastes

WASTE CATEGORY 2

Solid wastes which may decompose and may consist of soluble material which could cause pollution if allowed to enter water systems.

Ash, Clinker

Cement

Natural Man-made fibres

Wood (including trees and bushes, sawdust and sanderdust)

Wood Products (e.g. Hardboard, chipboard)

Paper (including oiled and tarred paper)

Cardboard, Fibreboard, Plasterboard

Metals and Metal Compounds (non-toxic)

Leather (excluding processing wastes)

Plastics

Carbonate, Gypsum

Silicate Slag, Boiler Scale, Shot Blasting residues (non-toxic)

Waste food or materials that include food or vegetable matter

Floor sweepings (that do not contain toxic substances)

Processing waste

Rubber and Latex

Soap

Cellulose waste

Household Waste and similar Wastes from Commercial and Industrial Premises

Other waste types may be included only with the prior written approval of the WRA

EXCLUSIONS Animal carcasses or parts thereof, animal processing waste

Sewage sludge

Animal processing waste

Animal based glue waste
